The Kathryn Tucker Windham Museum is located on the campus of Coastal Alabama College in Thomasville, Alabama. It is dedicated to preserving the works of native author, storyteller, and journalist, Kathryn Tucker Windham. Windham has spent much of her life recording Alabama's history and folklore. The museum takes visitors through Ms. Windham's early childhood in Thomasville, her career as a journalist and her rise to national attention as a storyteller.

Monroeville is best known as the home of Pulitzer Prize-winning author Harper Lee and her childhood friend, Truman Capote. Each year, in May, a production of "To Kill A Mockingbird" is presented at the Old Courthouse Museum by a local amateur group, the Mockingbird Players. The museum houses 3 permanent exhibits: Celebrating 100 Years: Monroe County Courthouse, Truman Capote's: A Childhood in Monroeville, and Harper Lee.

The Camden Shoe Shop Museum, owned and directed by Betty Anderson, pays homage to Anderson's parents and grandparents along with their hometowns of Camden and Gee's Bend. Guests are given tours personally by Betty, who not only entertains each and every guest with her captivating stories, but also educates citizens and tourists about local and regional history, quilting, civil rights, and religion. The museum includes an eclectic display of quilts, furniture, artwork, period clothing, documents, and knickknacks, along with her father's (Joe Anderson) historic shoe repair equipment, which dates to the 1800's.
